Mohawk HS top 9% in U.S. and top 21% in MA

- Ranked 2,567 of 19,908 across United States: Top 9%
- Ranked 74 of 353 within Massachusetts: Top 21%









- Massachusetts ranked 5th in the United States
- Based on percentage of high schools awarded gold or silver medals



U.S. News Comprehensive Rankings Methodology

• 2 Key Principles

- that a great high school must serve all of its students well,
 not just those who are college bound
- 2. and that it must be able to produce measurable academic outcomes to show it is successfully educating its student body across a range of performance indicators




U.S. News Comprehensive Rankings Methodology



- —Began with 28,561 U.S. public high schools
- —Screened-out 8,653 (30% of 28,561) schools
- 19,908 highs schools moved forward for ranking
 - —Screened-out 13,690 (69% of 19,908) schools
 - -6,218 highest scoring schools awarded medals
 - Gold: 1 500 (2.5% of 19,908)
 - Silver: 501 2,673 (10.9% of 19,908)
 - Bronze: 2,674 3,545 (17.8% of 19,908)











- Step 1: Determine whether each school's students were performing
 - better than statistically expected for students in that state
 - Reading and Math results on MCAS
 - —Factored in the percentages of economically disadvantaged students
 - —Performance had to be one-third of one standard deviation above the average







- Step 2: Determine whether disadvantaged students (low-income)
 - were outperforming disadvantaged students in that state
 - Reading and Math proficiency rates on MCAS
 - —Selected schools that were performing better than state averages







Step 3: Determine whether the graduation rate meets or

surpasses a basic benchmark

- —4-year graduation rate 68% or greater
- —Based on 2014 cohort
- —Students who entered 9th grade in the 2010-2011 school year







- Step 4: Determine college readiness performance
 - —Calculated a College Readiness Index
 - —Based on the school's Advanced Placement rate
 - Number of 12th-grade students in the 2013-2014 academic year
 who took at least one AP test before or during their senior year,
 - Divided by the number of 12th-graders,
 - and how well the students did on those tests.
